Medical Situation: Chest pains while hiking on Mt. Kilimanjaro

Diagnosis: Altitude Sickness

Action: 57 year old member was hiking on Mount Kilimanjaro and fell ill with chest pains, shortness of breath and intense tightness in the arms. Due to the patient's age and location, Geo-Blue arranged an emergency helicopter transfer from the mountainside so the patient could be admitted to the Nairobi Hospital, a GeoBlue contracted hospital. The attending physician at Nairobi Hospital holds a M.D. from the University of Chicago, and was a Research Fellow in Cardiology at the University of Washington. He is a Fellow of the American College of Cardiology and a Fellow of the American College of Physicians.

Geo-Blue coordinated admission and arranged direct billing at the hospital.

Outcome: Once the member received a thorough medical evaluation, she was cleared of any significant cardiac problems, was diagnosed with altitude sickness, a common and serious medical condition experienced by trekkers. Once the patient was fully recovered from the altitude sickness, she was discharged from the hospital and continued her holiday.
